2. Parents and guardians may visit their wards only on 1st and 3rd Sunday between 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. in summer. In winter, the timing will be between 10.00 a.m. to 3.30 p.m.
3. Visitors will meet their wards in the visiting room only. They are not allowed to enter the compartments of the boarding.
4. Outstation parents visiting their wards will have to take special permission from the Hostel Authority to see their wards on the days other than specified for visits. In case of any emergency visits, it can be arranged under the concerned authority's permission.
5. Entering the school premise with chewing pan, tobacco and other types of intoxications which can affect the school atmosphere are strictly prohibited.
6. Visitors are not allowed to deliver any kind of junk food (Like oily food, meat etc.) to the boarders without prior permission from the concerned authority.

## HOSTEL RULES

Every hosteller must abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel being listed. Stringent action will be taken up against any violation or delinquency.

### DO's

1. Boarders must attend Night Roll call at their respective compartments respectively.
2. In case of sickness, the hostellers have to inform their respective wardens and School Medical officer. They are not supposed to take medicine on their own on advice of their co-hostellers.
3. Hostellers will take the sole responsibility of their belongings.
4. Hostellers must maintain a discipline of mutual respect among themselves. None of them is to be discriminated against race, religion, caste, sex, age, family condition, orphanage etc.
5. A Hosteller must leave the school for home only after he/she submits an application at the school gate duly signed by the Hostel authority along with the authorised guardians.
6. If any hosteller is absent for 2 or more days from boarding, then he/she should explain the reason with guardian to the concern authority with required documents.
7. Hostellers should follow the daily routine of the hostel and school time table.

### DON'T's

1. No hosteller is allowed to keep more than Rs. 100/- in cash in his possession and the higher amount of money must be deposited to Schools Children Bank.
2. No hosteller is allowed to keep unauthorised materials like mobile phone, jewellery item, music player, knife, sword, electric heater, Kettle, iron, playing card, adult magazines etc. in his possession.
3. No hostellers are allowed to invite their day-scholar colleagues or any outsiders to the hostel premises for their personal interaction or any reason.
4. No hosteller will be allowed to organize any kind of meeting in the hostel premises to unite the students for any kind of violent or destructive thoughts.
5. No hosteller is allowed to borrow, lend, steal and snatch any amount of money from co-hostellers or classmates.
6. No hosteller shall damage any school property which is provided to them.
7. No hosteller should have a habit of smoking, consuming alcohol, Gutka or any pan masala, chewing of tobacco and intoxicants.
8. No hosteller is allowed to make telephone calls other than Telephone Schedule provided to them.



# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## ✓ Do's

1. Students must maintain a discipline of mutual respect though it may be younger or elder.
2. Students should attend school regularly with a minimum of 75% attendance which is the important criteria of being eligible for appearing final examination.
3. Students should appear all the school examinations as compulsory and in case of their inability, they must bring their parents/guardians with reasonable application.
4. Students must note that they must reach school in time to attend school assembly as late comers are not entertained.
5. A student of the school must wear full uniform to enter the school campus and in special cases, prior permission must be taken from the school authority.
6. It must be noted that any lost of personal things like bicycle, jewellery, books, notebooks, pen, pencil etc. will be the self responsibility of the student.
7. Students have to converse only in English within the school premises.
8. Students must apply leave in time according to their needs with the consent of the parents and guardians.
9. Students must use prescribed diary, notebooks, examination and practical books & Notebooks as compulsory.
10. Students must note that any claim or complaint should be submitted to the Principal/concerned VP's and the same will be considered by the Principal/ concerned VP's.

## ✗ Dont's

- i. Students must not take pan, tobacco and any other types of intoxication.
- ii. Students must not use unfair means during the examinations and any negligence on their part will be given serious punishment.
- iii. Students should not attempt to quarrel, steal, disobey and to be indiscipline, rudely in character, irregular in day-to-day schooling process.
- iv. Students must note that romance, love affairs and romantic elements are strictly prohibited inside the school atmosphere. And also it is important to note that any married or eloped person will not be accepted as a student of this school.
- v. Students of this school must not put tattoo on their body and if this is not followed, he/she will be expelled from the school.
- vi. Students must not do any activity which may affect the learning atmosphere of the school. The activities may include making noise, nap, quarrelling etc.
- vii. Students must not go outside the school campus during the school hour without taking prior information from school authority.
- viii. Students are not allowed to bring books, periodicals, posters of objectionable nature to school.
- ix. Students must not pursue any anti-school activity. If any is found, the student shall be expelled immediately.
- x. None of the students must discriminate any fellow students based on their race, religion, caste, sex, age, family condition, orphanage etc.

**NOTES TO THE PARENTS** Parents/Guardians are requested to extend their valuable and wholehearted co-operation to the school in maintaining discipline including diligence, initiative, leadership, upright behaviour and courtesy among students. Their co-operation is particularly solicited for the following:

- i) Attending promptly to all school functions, celebrations, happenings etc.
- ii) To communicate the school administrators for giving new ideas and valuable suggestions.
- iii) To check progress report of the students regularly.
- iv) Every student, except the fee concession student(s) or the fee exempted students of this school is required to pay tuition fee for all the twelve months of a year.
- v) To provide a valid mobile number of the guardian at the time of admission.
- vi) To pay monthly fee on or before 10th of every month (otherwise late fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged). Fees, once paid are not refundable at any condition.
- vii) No admission to next class will be made of, no transfer certificate will be issued until and unless twelve months' monthly fees of the previous year is fully cleared.
- viii) To visit school when he or she is asked to attend by the school administrators.
- ix) No exemption of monthly fee is made for any holidays, general strike, curfew or any interrupted periods/day(s).
- x) To meet the school authority with an application if his/her ward(s) is/are absent in the school for 3 (three) consecutive days and more.
- xi) Every student must submit a photo copy of Aadhaar card at the time of admission.

## FOR GIRLS ONLY

- i. If any girl wants to take leave during school hour, she should take acknowledgement from the female teacher-in-charge before seeking leave from V.P.
- ii. Girls are not allowed to dye their hair and use nail colour.
- iii. Girls should tie their hair in two ponytails if their hair is above the shoulder, and if hair is below the shoulder, then they should make two simple braids.
- iv. Threading is strictly prohibited.
